Academic discipline is cultural anthropology, ethnology and related fields (e.g. area study, sociology, linguistics, history, folklore, comparative culture and material culture) with a focus on culture or society in West Asia, Middle East or North Africa. The candidate must have academic achievements on the dynamics of modern Islam based on field work. It is desirable that the candidate has some interest in material culture.
- 4. The selected candidate will be employed from April 1, 2016.
- 5. Requirements
  - (1) A Ph.D. or equivalent academic or other experience.
  - (2) The ability to communicate in English and Japanese.

## 6.Process

Interviews will be conducted following selection of candidates based on documentation. Invitations to interviews are tentatively scheduled on September, 2015. Travel and accommodation expenses will not be provided.
